


## Cherry Blossoms



#### Materials Needed:

- Paper
- Tissue paper, newspaper, construction paper, etc. Depending on paper choice multiple layers may be needed
- Twigs
- Depending on your craft choice, size and bendiness of twig may be important!
- Scissors
- Glue and/or tape
- Optional string

### **Craft Ideas:**

- Isabella Thorndike Church inspired wall piece. (Thordnike Church is a participating artist in the upcoming exhibition *Celebrating Wild Beauty*)
- Flower crown



#### For a Four Petal Flower

Similar to folding paper to make a snowflake



- 1. Start with a 4-inch by 4-inch square of paper
- 2. Fold the square in half
- 3. Fold in half again so you have a 2 inch by 2 inch square
- Fold diagonally so all "open" sides are layered (you should have a triangle with the shortest part being the "open" layers, meaning you should be able to count each layer)
- 5. Cut a curve along that edge
- 6. Unfold paper, you have a flower!



















### For a Five Petal Flower

This is more challenging, follow the video for extra guidance!

- 1. Start with a 4 inch by 4 inch square of paper
- 2. Fold the square in half, the fold should face you
- 3. Fold the bottom right corner up so the right edge meets the top, crease, and unfold
- 4. Fold the top right corner down so the right edge meets the bottom, crease, and unfold
- 5. There should be a creased "x" on the right half of your rectangle
- 6. Now fold the bottom left corner to the center of the "x" and crease
- Fold the left sided shape so the bottom edge (lined up with the bottom left of the "x") so it now meets the far left side. You should have a triangle shape now.
- 8. Fold the bottom right corner up so the bottom edge meets the left side's triangle
- Fold the right side back behind the left side, you should have a triangle (don't worry if the top part looks too layered, we are focused on the lower half)
- 10. Now work on the **smallest triangle** cut a curve going from the middle of the left side to the top of the triangle, then cut the tip of the top of the curve off
- 11. Unfold and you should have a five petal cherry blossom!

Depending on the craft you would like to make, glue and/or tape will work for adhering. There are plenty of crafts possible with this idea in mind.
